



Clearing Browser History



Google Chrome

1. In the browser bar, enter:
chrome://settings/clearBrowserData
2. Click on **Advanced**.
3. Select the following:
 - Browsing history
 - Download history
 - Cookies and other site data
 - Cached images and files

Note: From the time range drop-down menu, you can choose the period of time for which you want to clear cached information. To clear your entire cache, select all time.
4. Click **Clear** data.
5. Exit/quit all browser windows and re-open the browser.



Mozilla Firefox

1. Click on the hamburger button  and then Select **Options**.
- Note:** If the menu bar is hidden, press **Alt** to make it visible.
2. Click on the **Privacy & Security** option in the left navigation pane.
3. In the History section, click the **Clear History** button.
4. In the **Clear Recent History** window, change the Time range to clear option to desired time frame.
5. Click the **Clear Now** button to clear browsing history data for the selected time frame.
6. Exit/quit all browser windows and re-open the browser.



Internet Explorer 11 and greater

1. Select **Tools** (via the Gear Icon) > **Safety** > **Delete browsing history**.

Note: If the menu bar is hidden, press **Alt** to make it visible.

2. **Deselect Preserve Favorites** website data, and select:
 - Temporary Internet files or Temporary Internet files and website files
 - Cookies or Cookies and website data
 - History
3. Click **Delete**. You will see a confirmation at the bottom of the window when the process is complete.
4. Exit/quit all browser windows and re-open the browser.



Microsoft Edge for Windows 10

1. Click the **Hub** button  in the upper-right corner of the window.
2. Click the **History** icon  to open the history menu.
3. Click **Clear History**.
4. Select the following:
 - Browsing history
 - Cookies and saved website data
 - Cached data and files
 - Download History
5. Click **Clear** to erase the selected data.
6. When you're done, click the **Hub** button to close.
7. Exit/quit all browser windows and re-open the browser.



Apple Safari 10 and greater

1. Click the **History menu** at the top of the screen.
2. Open the **Show All History** view.
3. To clear everything, click **Clear History**.
4. Go to Safari > Quit Safari or press **Command Q** to exit the browser completely.
